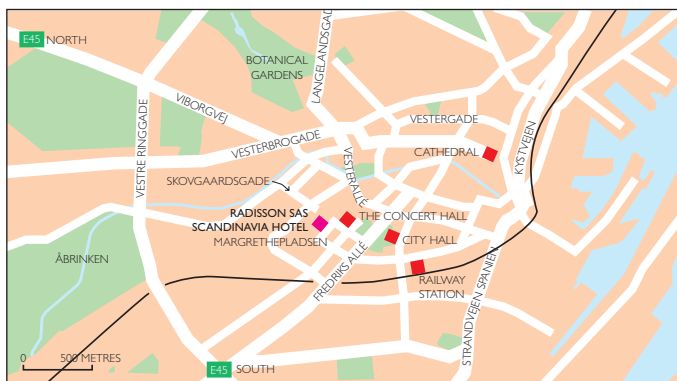

CITY FACTS

- **Den Gamle By - The Old Town:** Historical buildings with original interior and exhibitions in idyllic street settings are on show in this open-air museum.
- **ARoS Aarhus Art Museum:** On 8 April 2004 the art museum opens its doors to 4,800 sqm a permanent collections, special exhibitions, activity and introduction rooms and special activities for children and young people.
- **Tivoli Friheden:** The old amusement park celebrates its 100th anniversary on 31 July 2004. Tivoli Friheden is full of fun, games and entertainment along with being a delight with its beautiful gardens, the entertainments and the many amusements for children and adults.
- **Two major old churches:** The Cathedral - the longest church in Denmark - has the most frescos; the largest organ; and its triptych is undoubtedly Denmark's largest artistic medieval treasure. The Church of Our Lady is richly decorated. From the central nave you can descend the staircase to the crypt - the oldest stone crypt in Scandinavia.
